The "Best Depiction," award goes to: Mel Rivera for his: "Nuestra Senora de la Paz." The judges felt it was a simple beautiful, but very impactful piece, tender with beautiful technique and choice of colors.

The "Pastor's Choice," award goes to Catherine Robles Shaw for her: "St. Ursula." With the recent tragedies in Las Vegas, Nevada and other losses in our world, Catherine's, "St. Ursula," speaks to the heart of the pastor in remembrance for those she saved as well as the sacrifice of her own life. For this reason, this piece is the, "Pastor's Choice."

The, "Third Place," award goes to Adrian Montoya for his: "Veronica's Veil." This is a winner because of the extremely heart-felt work and incorporation of so many New Mexican symbols, thoughts and beliefs. One judge felt there was a different style of creating a cross. Also, the simplicity touched the hearts and souls of the judges.

The, "Second Place," award goes to Jason Salazar for his: "Nativity." The judges commented on the fact that this piece has an incredible sculptural quality, that the work emotes a special quality and the light enhancement shining down on the baby Jesus is truly wonderful.



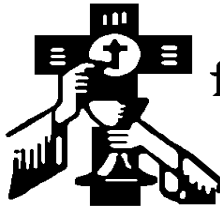

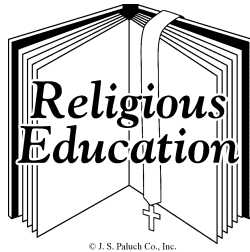
## Religious Education
