RELIGIOUS EDUCATION
REGISTRATION BEGINS JULY 22, 2017

Religious Education registration will begin on July 22, 2017 for regular catechism in addition to the Right of Christian Initiation of Children (RCIC), First Communion and Confirmation. Don't wait for First Communion to start your children learning about God. The San Felipe de Neri catechism program begins as early as kindergarten with the English language CCD program on Sundays from 9:00 am to 10:30 am, so parents and students can attend the 11:00 am Mass. The first day of class will be August 20, 2017. The Spanish language CCD program will be on Tuesday evenings from 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm beginning on August 22, 2017. All Religious Education classes are being held at San Felipe de Neri Parish School.

The cost is \$25.00 and registration will take place after each of the Masses beginning on July 22, 2017 and weekdays at the parish office. We will need copies of your child's Birth and Baptismal Certificates for the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation.

**From the desk of Deacon Maurice Menke:
Marriage Annulment**

Jesus Christ valued marriage highly. He repeated the ancient Biblical words, “They are no longer two, but one flesh, therefore, let no one separate what God has joined.” The Catholic Church believes that marriage has been given a special dignity. Marriage is an enduring partnership in which husband and wife establish a loving life-giving relationship. This sacramental bond becomes a special, exclusive and unbreakable state of life.

An annulment is an official Church declaration that a previous marriage is no longer binds a person spiritually. This is issued only after a thorough evaluation of the prior marriage, and states that the marriage never had all the required essential elements which include sufficient maturity, free choice and emotional capacity on the part of the spouses, as well as technical elements.

The Holy Father, Pope Francis, on the 15th of August 2015, promulgated by publication a *motu proprio* entitled *Mitis Iudex Dominus Iesus* which took effect on December 8, 2015.

We now have two processes for annulments– the Ordinary Process and the Brief Process. Cases no longer require decision from second instance. There are 15 new grounds available in the Brief Process and many updated procedures.

Each case is unique, and involving different individuals and circumstances. I have assisted people with their annulments from 1990 until 2002 in the Archdiocese of Omaha and from 2002 to present day here in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe. I have attended several courses in Canon Law involving marriage annulments and am certified to serve as Procurator, Advocate or Judge in annulment cases. I prayerfully look forward to assisting anyone who may be considering requesting a declaration of annulment.

THE MERCY, POWER, AND LOVE OF GOD

The first reading today, from the book of Wisdom, makes its point over and over, at least five times in five verses! God is mighty, but lenient to all. God's power is shown in kindness and clemency, not in harshness and condemnation, and those who govern God's people must govern in the same way, with kindness. This loving kindness and gentleness is not contrary to God's might, but is a direct result of God's primacy over all. Who are we, then, to judge what is in the hearts of our fellow Christians and all people, when God commands justice with love and clemency?

Likewise, the Holy Spirit makes up for our ignorance of what we need, speaking in a language we do not yet understand. But God knows our needs before we do, understands the intercessions of the Spirit, and helps us in our weakness. This is our hope: God's mercy, power, and love.
