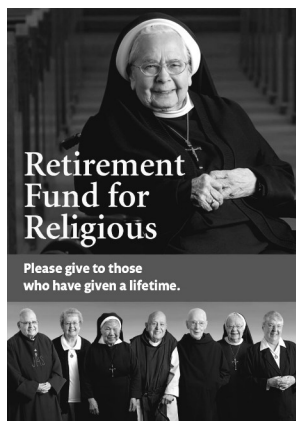
First Reconciliation, which is **mandatory**, for all First Communion students, is Monday, December 3rd at 6:30 pm in the church.
